Dear Parents/Guardians,

It is hard to believe that it is nearly June and final exams are upon us. It has been two long years since the last time we administered Regents exams. This is another step back towards normalcy for us (not that all of the students will be happy about this ☺). We wanted to take the opportunity to review all of the procedures we have in place for Regents exams since again it has been two years since we have administered them.

On the back of this letter is the June 2022 Final Examination schedule for your reference.

On June 1<sup>st</sup>, students in US History/Government will be taking their Regents Exam. Treat this as a regular school day for all students. Those students who need to take this exam will be directed by their teacher where to go during that time, all other students will follow their regular schedule. For all other exams, June 15–23, 2022, attendance at school is by exam only. Morning exams are scheduled to begin at 8:00 a.m. and afternoon exams are scheduled to begin at 12:00 p.m. Students should arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the start of their exam. Students arriving late will not be permitted entrance to their exam after 10:00 a.m. for the morning session and after 2:00p.m. for the afternoon session. Also, per NYS Department of Education testing security regulations, students are not permitted to bring any electronic communication devices, including but not limited to: cell phones, iPods, Smartwatches, Fitbits, etc., to exam locations. Should they bring them to school, students will be asked to shut them off and turn them over to an adult to be placed in a secure location within their exam room. We are strongly encouraging students to leave these devices at home. There can be no exceptions to these rules. A student found in possession of a communication device may result in their exam being invalidated. Please reinforce these expectations with your child.

Your child will have the option to ride his or her regular bus to school in the morning.

The district will provide modified dismissal bus runs per the schedule listed below:

Breakfast will be available Tuesday, June 21<sup>st</sup> through Thursday, June 23<sup>rd</sup>.
