1. Engagement Rubric – there was a discussion around having a default option to a score of 3 so teacher would be able to alter the individual scores from there to a 1, 2, or 4. We also discussed adding in a .5 (ex. 1.5, 2.5, 3.5). Sean let us know that there is a committee that will be reviewing the rubric.
2. ALC – there was a discussion around ALC. There are some blocks without a teacher assigned because there is not enough staff to fill it full time.
BPT also discussed Patty having access to the alerts so she will know if a student is missing, and they happen to be in the ALC.
Sean will work with Patty to address a concern of students that are not assigned in the ALC stopping into the room.
3. Hall sweeps – there was a general discussion of hall sweeps and their effectiveness. BPT was asking for the data that has been collected to be reviewed. Sean and the admin team have met to review the Q3 data and will discuss sharing it with the staff at their next meeting.
4. BPT elections/dates – there will be 3 positions to fill this year. There will be two 3-year positions available and one 2-year position available. Information will be coming out to faculty via an email from Jackie soon.
5. Faculty meetings – yes, we will have in-person Faculty meetings again. Sean has been giving teachers time to work on the grading policy/retakes.
6. Bright spots – BPT discussed bringing this back to help praise our hard-working colleagues. If you have a “bright spot” to share, please send it to Sean to be included in the Ranger Updates.
7. Academic Eligibility – BPT discussed the information that Amy Sullivan shared, and Sean will follow up. More information to follow.
8. Substitute teachers - BPT raised the question about substitute teachers having a district email. They do not. This is district policy, but they can use the call button in the classroom if the need arises.
BPT is looking into how substitutes can have access to icons on our homepage (Care team alert, student awareness).
Note: all substitutes are reminded by Julie Hill that students need presigned passes to come to and leave advisements.
