### GRADUATION PREPARATIONS

As you can imagine, planning a graduation ceremony for more than 300 seniors, their families and our faculty and staff is a complex and lengthy process. ### RESPONSIBILITIES OF SENIORS

Most seniors end their high school days the same way they began them: by behaving in a courteous and responsible fashion. I am very proud of the fine behavior exhibited by the overwhelming majority of our students. However, to make sure that everyone knows what our expectations are for seniors during these last weeks, I would like to emphasize a few points.

- There is no such thing as Senior Skip Day.

- Attendance and punctuality continue to be important throughout the remainder of the school year. Many courses have year-end projects that are due in the weeks to come, and these projects often count heavily in the student's average. Many review activities are conducted in class in June and attendance will almost certainly result in higher final grades. The end of the senior year is a time to demonstrate adult habits of attendance.

- Successful completion of the Senior Project is required for graduation. Students need to meet deadlines and expectations in order to meet this requirement. Any questions should be directed to Mr. DeMarte at [DDeMarte@spencerportschools.org](mailto:DDeMarte@spencerportschools.org).

- Students who engage in senior pranks will be subject to the usual school disciplinary measures. In addition, they may be denied attendance at any or all senior activities including graduation. Vandalism and other public acts of disrespect reflect very poorly on our school and our community, and I know you will join me in strongly discouraging these activities as we finish the year.

- \*Seniors will be required to turn in their district issued laptops, the charging cable, and the carrying case. If there are damages to these items, we encourage families to notify the district as soon as possible. Once a date and time has been established for laptop collection, all seniors and their guardians will be notified.

The Class of 2022 have been incredible leaders for our high school community over these past two years. They have demonstrated incredible resiliency, perseverance, grace, and good humor through it all. We could not be prouder of them. I will miss their leadership and all that they offer our school. As they close out their days together, I wish them the very best of memories. I know that I can count on you at home to help your child see the end-of-year activities as part of the transition from adolescence to independence.
