



# Senior Year: Paint Your Parking Spot

**Class of 2024,**

Welcome to your SENIOR YEAR!!

As a kickoff event, seniors will be able to customize their parking spots. This will be your parking spot for the duration of the school year during school hours (7:00 am–3:00 pm). Because it is your spot, no one else can park there...even with your permission. People who violate this policy will receive consequences. Not driving? No problem, you can still participate by painting a Spencerport-themed spot for general parking.

1. **Design Approval Form & Sign-Up Form** must be completed and submitted by Wednesday, August 16<sup>th</sup>. Design approval form is attached at the end of this letter and the sign-up form can be found in our class Schoology page. Once approved, you are committed to that design.

Painting will take place on the following dates and times:

- Friday, August 18<sup>th</sup> (PAINT THE BASE): 12:00pm – 4:00pm
- Monday, August 21<sup>st</sup>: 9:00am – 3:00pm
- Thursday, August 24<sup>th</sup>: 1:00pm – 7:00pm.

We highly recommend you come on Friday, August 18<sup>th</sup> to paint your base color so it is dry and ready for your design the following week!

2. **Design Guidelines:** Your design must be within the guidelines of Spencerport's Code of Conduct – so no references to drugs, alcohol, smoking, gangs, inappropriate behavior, and/or anything that could be divisive, etc. You can use your name, jersey number, instrument you play, reflect your favorite teams, your hobbies, show your school spirit, etc. Your spot should reflect who you are as a person. Prohibited items will be painted over in black at the discretion of the administration and disciplinary action may be taken.

3. There will be a **\$10 painting fee** paid in cash or check (payable to SHS Class of 2024) due when you arrive to paint. **YOU WILL PICK YOUR PARKING SPOT WITH MS. ANTOSH/MRS. WYANT UPON PAYMENT!**



### Materials Needed:

- Paint–Latex, Exterior– Water Based
  - \*No oil–based, reflective paint, or spray paint\*
  - Gallon for background/base color
  - Quart for accent color(s)
- Brushes, rollers, and/or sponges to apply paint
- Masking tape to mark a 2–inch border from parking lines
- Chalk to sketch design
- Broom to sweep spot free of dirt and pebbles
- Plastic drop cloth to put under paint cans
- Plastic containers for water, paint, and brushes
- Stool or towel to sit on
- Sunscreen, hats, sunglasses, water, snacks

### Painting Tips:

- Tape the edges of your spot with a 2–inch margin before painting.
- Do not paint on parking lines or curbs.
- Sweep the dirt and pebbles before you paint.
- Use chalk to draw out your sketch.
- Start painting at the front of your spot (front bumper to back bumper) because others may be working next to you, and you cannot step on their spot.
- Consider making a stencil ahead of time for lettering or detailed images to save a lot of time.
- Limit your paint palette, as the quarts of paint are expensive or share colors with a friend.
